

Savvy Savings from \$5 to \$10 per Week

Saving money is a blast! Think about it, for every cent we save on anything - that money can be invested to earn money for us. Today's saving idea is for good old American *gasoline*. Just this morning I compared regular *gasoline* prices within a 7 mile radius from my office. The prices ranged from \$1.79 to \$2.39 per gallon or a .60 cent differential per gallon. Which adds up to a \$12 saving on a 20 gallon fill-up.

Gas is an expenditure that we can easily save \$5 to \$10 per week. Investing \$10 a week adds up to \$520 per year. By investing our weekly gasoline savings of \$10 weekly over the course of 20 years at 6% compounded, grows to \$21,943.

So how do we get started? I use the GasBuddy.com app. This site shows the cheapest gasoline prices near me. Why pay a higher price when it is unnecessary. The savings are immediate and can add up quickly.
